

MS SAC Minutes

Meeting Date: Sunday, August 2, 2020 (Zoom)

Appointed Secretary: Dawn Messer

The meeting was called to order at 1:05 PM. Committee members in attendance were Cynthia Dedeaux, Dawn Messer, Laurie Moore, Candi Workman, and Amanda Zeigler. Reg Shurden, MS SJD was also in attendance. Mabel Sims was absent. Cynthia asked that all in attendance silence their phones. She also went over the procedure for recusing yourself on zoom should it be necessary.

Updates on State Clubs returning to practice and competition

Cynthia informed the committee that most clubs had returned to practice following their local and state mandates as well as CDC guidelines. Feedback she had received from many clubs was that most would not be traveling to big or away competitions but rather hold smaller in house meets with their respective teams.

Due to the smaller/ in house competitions the committee revisited the state's requirement that qualifying meets must have a minimum two judge panel per event for all levels competing. R&P pg. 82 states that it is permissible for compulsory levels 1-5 to use one judge panels at invitational meets. It was agreed that giving meet directors and the clubs that might host a meet the option to use one judge panels would be financially beneficial to them.

Motion was made by Candi Workman to rescind the state requirement of two judge panels for Compulsory Levels 1-5 at all in state competitions and follow the guidelines for judging panels detailed in R&P pg. 82. This will be in effect for the 2020-21 season. Motion was seconded by Amanda Zeigler. All in favor

Calendar/Planner

Cynthia verified that all committee members had received the calendar/planner in their respective emails.

Dawn Messer will retain the position.

Declaration Date

Motion made by Candi Workman to set the declaration date for the 2020-21 season as February 22, 2021. Seconded by Amanda Zeigler. All in favor

State Meet Qualifying Requirements and Receipt of Regional Apparel

- a. Motion made by Amanda Zeigler to rescind the state requirement for Levels 1, 2, XB, and XS that in order to attend State Meet they must compete in 2 (two) in state meets. This motion is for the 2020-21 season.
Seconded by Dawn Messer. All in favor

- b. Motion made by Amanda Zeigler to rescind the state requirement that to receive Regional Apparel from the state that all Level 6-10 and Xcel athletes must compete in 1 (one) in state meet. This motion is for the 2020-21 season. Seconded by Laurie Moore.
All in favor

State Meet will be held in Vicksburg for the 2020-21 season. Laurie still has the judge's gifts from the 2019-2020 season to use for the upcoming season. Candi has the trophies from the 2019-2020 season to use for the upcoming season – she will get the date changed.

Competition Form

Cynthia verified that all committee members had received the previous year's form for review. Other than current dates, no changes will be made for the upcoming 2020-21 season.

State Meet Judges Selection

This item was tabled for a later date. Cynthia noted that the list needs to be turned in to M. Dykes no later than November 1, 2020.
